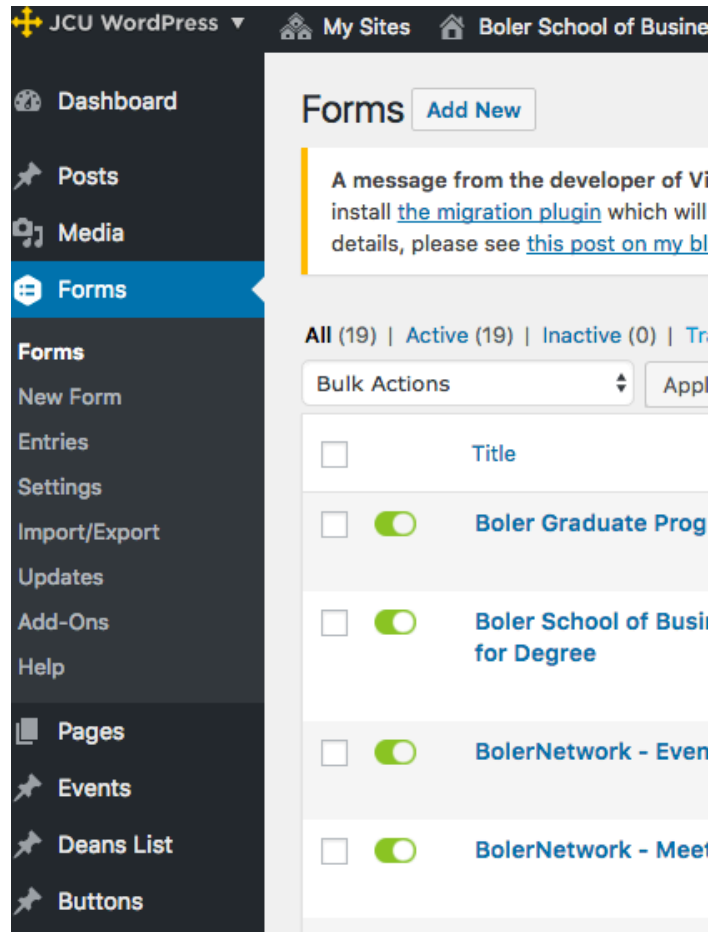
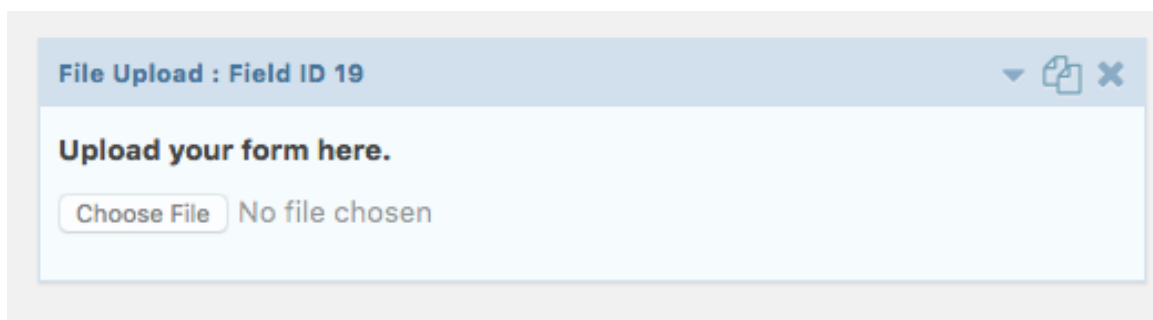


How to hide a field in Gravity Forms


1. Go to the WordPress Dashboard and find your form that contains a file upload field.



2. Now find the file upload field and click on it.




3. Select the 'Advanced' tab and under 'Visibility' select Hidden.
